- SIGN this letter and return it to our office via mail. After signing, mail your statement in the enclosed envelope with sufficient postage to our office. It must be received at our office at PO Box 250, Red Bluff, CA 96080 before 5:00 pm on November 25, 2020. Postmarks will not count; OR
- Fax or Scan and email this letter to our office. It must be received at our office before 5:00 pm on November 25, 2020. Fax (530) 527-1140, email: elections@co.tehama.ca.us
