NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Tehama County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 29, 2010 at 10:45 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in Board Chambers, 727 Oak Street, Red Bluff, California, on the following matters:

PARCEL MAP #09-08, MARK GUNSAULS. This Map creates a 10.52 acre parcel, a 10.55 acre parcel and a 10.57 acre parcel in an RE-A-MH-B:435; Residential Estates - Animal Raising Combining - Mobilehome Combining - Special Building Site (10 Acre Minimum) Combining Zoning District. The Map and associated Exception from the requirements of the Tehama County Land Development and Engineering Design Standards was approved by the Tehama County Planning Commission on 05-27-10, and thereafter appealed to the Board of Supervisors by the Director of Public Works. The project site is located approximately 3/4 mile west of the City of Red Bluff on the west side of Wilder Road approximately 400 feet south of the Reeds Creek Road / Wilder Road intersection. Described as a portion of Section 26, T.27N, R.4W, M.D.B. & M. APN: 024-080-84. Approximately 31.45 acres.

The Map and associated Exception was approved by the Tehama County Planning Commission on 05-27-10 by a 4:0:1 vote.

All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard. Please be advised that if you challenge the above-entitled matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered at or prior to the public hearing to the Tehama County Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Office, Room 12, County Courthouse, P.O. Box 250, Red Bluff, CA 96080.

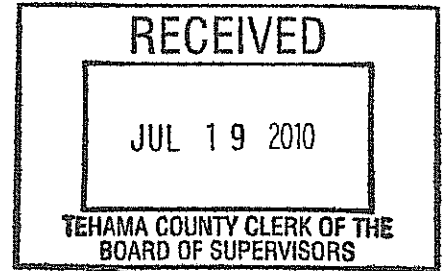

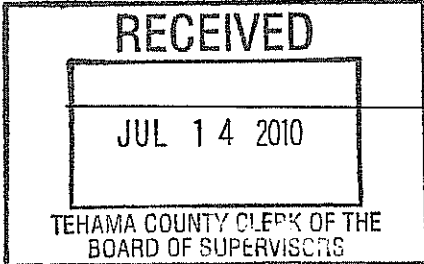
