### DID YOU KNOW?

- Each year, 50 million Christmas trees are purchased in the U.S. Most of those will go to the landfill. Why not consider purchasing a potted tree this year? It will be with you for years to come, benefit your home and garden, and **cut down on landfilled trees**.
- It is estimated that if every American family wrapped just three presents in reused materials, like newspapers or magazines, it would save enough paper to cover 45,000 football fields. This year, take an easy step towards reducing paper waste and wrap all your gifts in reusable materials.
- According to the EPA, about 40% of all battery sales occur during the holiday season. This year, **remember to properly recycle spent batteries.** Rechargeable batteries can be recycled at any retail store that sells rechargeable batteries. Alkaline batteries can be recycled by

placing spent batteries in an orange battery bag and placing the sealed orange battery bag inside your curbside recycling bin for convenient pickup. Call (530) 528-1103 or visit <a href="www.tehamacountylandfill.com">www.tehamacountylandfill.com</a> for a list of locations where you can pick up your next free orange battery bag. *NOTE: The City of Corning* does not participate in the orange battery bag program. Residents of Corning can drop off spent alkaline batteries at Corning Disposal Recycling Center or Corning Ace Hardware.
