- **Outside:** Products including fertilizers, pesticides, weed killers and pool chemicals.
- Inside: Household chemicals including nail polish remover, hair relaxers, bleach, oven cleaners, detergents, drain cleaners, and metal polishes.
- In the Garage: Motor oil, paint thinners, spray paints, old gasoline/fuel, varnishes and oil-based paints.

The Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency provides public access to these unwanted, <u>usable</u> products for reuse through the **REAP** program, which stands for **Re**use of **A**vailable **P**roducts.
