## DID YOU KNOW?

The waste reduction and recycling efforts of a single person make a substantial and measurable difference. **Consider this:**

- More than **100 billion pieces of junk mail** are delivered in the United States each year. That breaks out to 848 pieces per household with an average weight of 41 pounds.

• The 2000 United States Census reported that there are 21,013 households in Tehama County. That would mean that, **in one year, 17,819,024 pieces of junk mail are delivered to Tehama County residents**, weighing in at a whopping 861,533 pounds.

• Experts say that contacting marketers to **remove yourself from mailing lists can eliminate at least 80% of your junk mail**. For Tehama County, that would equate to 14,255,219 fewer pieces of junk mail delivered each year (that's 689,226.4 pounds, folks). That is impressive!

Not sure what to do with all that junk mail in the meantime? **Recycle it!** Recycling 2,000 pounds of paper saves 17 trees, three cubic yards of landfill space, two barrels of oil, 7,000 gallons of water, and 4,100KW of electricity (enough to power the average American home for five months). Plus, it'll save you money. You see, every single person can make a difference!
