STUDENT REQUIREMENTS-YOU MUST BE:

- At least 16 years old by Election Day
- A high school student with a grade point average of, at least, 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Attending a high school in Tehama County
- A student in good standing that likes working with the public.





AS A STUDENT POLLWORKER, YOU WILL:

- Serve as an active member of a Precinct Board at a polling place
- Assist with the opening and closing of a polling place on Election Day
- Direct and process voters, demonstrating how the voting system works
- Receive \$20.00 per training class, and \$110.00 for working Election Day
- Have an important community service project to add to a resume or college application
- You may earn community service hours toward graduation or extra credit in the classroom, depending on the policy of your teacher and your school

DUTIES OF A CLERK-

- Attend a training class
- Arrive at your assigned polling place at 6:00 a.m. on Election Day



Perform duties assigned by the Inspector

- Stay at the polling place after the polls close and assist with closing procedures.
 - You can assist voters if you speak a language in addition to English
