More than 81 million people reported taking part in a barbecue to celebrate Independence Day last year. This holiday, **save money by throwing away less**. Not sure how? Here's a few ideas to get you started:

- Choose to reuse. Pack food in reusable containers and bags.
- **Encourage recycling** by placing designated bins marked "cans and bottles" at your celebration.
- **Cut down on food waste** by saving your tasty food for workweek lunches or giving some to your guests to take home.
- **Reduce waste** by providing permanent markers for guests to label their cups.
- **Buy recycled.** When purchasing paper towels, plastic cups, and the like, look for the option containing post-consumer recycled content. After all, it's not recycling if nobody buys or makes use of the end (recycled) product.

Small efforts can reduce summer garbage amounts immensely, allowing for the conservation of precious resources and landfill space for future generations. What's more American than that?
