DID YOU KNOW?

It has become an unwritten rule of society that we recycle whenever possible, but what about tires?

In the past 2 years the **Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency has collected 11,585 tires through amnesty events alone.** Wonder where they all come from? Many are generated from residents' backyards, sheds or garages, but many more come from illegal dumping in forested areas, agricultural land and other remote locations.

Here are some good reasons to recycle your tires properly:

- ⇒ **Shredded tires can also be used as rubber mulch**, which is a great alternative to wood chips in gardens, planters and playgrounds.
- ⇒ Tires can be shredded even smaller into a substance known as crumb rubber. This substance is used in creations such as rubber-modified asphalt, running tracks and artificial playing fields, just to name a few.

BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING... DONE RIGHT

No matter how you recycle, the County thanks you for your efforts. Here's a tip to maximize your recycling efforts the next time you finish a refreshing, cold beverage:

- Take your aluminum, glass, and plasic beverage containers to your local recycling center for a <u>cash refund</u> (5 g for containers less than 24 oz. and 10 g for containers 24 oz. or larger).
- Toss your rinsed beverage containers into your <u>blue curbside</u> recycling cart with your other recyclables.
