DID YOU KNOW?

Plenty of cleaning products can be made with everyday items in your cupboard, from baking soda to vinegar, and are often times less expensive and just as effective as the store bought cleaners.

- To make a simple **glass cleaner** try mixing ¼ to ½ cup of white vinegar with a quart of warm water in a spray bottle. Spray your windows or mirrors and wipe dry with a clean rag.
- A **nontoxic wood furniture polish** can be made very simply as well. In a small glass jar, mix ¼ cup of olive oil (or any other vegetable oil), ¼ cup

Select to opt out of receiving Tehama County's 4Rs News monthly e-newsletter. white vinegar, and 20-30 drops of lemon essential oil. Shake well before using. Dip a clean, dry cloth into the polish and rub the wood in the direction of the grain. Use a soft brush to work the polish into corners or tight places.

BEVERAGE CONTAINER RECYCLING... DONE RIGHT

No matter how you recycle, the County thanks you for your efforts. Here's a tip to maximize your recycling efforst the next time you finish a refreshing, cold beverage:

- Take your aluminum, glass and plasic beverage containers to your local recycling center for a <u>cash refund</u> (5 ¢ for containers less than 24 oz. and 10 ¢ for containers 24 oz. or larger).
- Toss your rinsed beverage containers into your <u>blue curbside</u> <u>recycling cart</u> with your other recyclables.
