A mature, healthy oak tree is estimated to have 250,000 leaves. Why waste all that goodness by sending it to the landfill? This fall, **compost your yard waste and gutter debris**. It will help return nutrients to the soil and cut down on landfilled waste. Visit www.tehamacountylandfill.com for composting tips.

About 65 million gallons of paint is discarded each year in the United States. Why not **consider donating unused latex paint** to the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill's Paint Swap (must be in original containers with a label and a lid)? While you're there, you might find some paint that you can use!





The process of recycling paper instead of making it from new material generates 74% less air pollution and uses 50% less water. This fall, support manufacturers that are making efforts to conserve our valuable natural resources by choosing items made of recycled materials, like blankets and fleeces made of recycled plastic bottles.
