LEARN HOW TO MAKE COMPOST

Have recent newspaper articles about separating your food waste from your trash gotten you thinking about starting a backyard compost pile? Not sure where to get started? Well, you are in luck! The Tehama County Solid Waste Management Agency will be holding a backyard composting class at our Agency office located at the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill. The class will focus on starting a compost pile, how to keep your pile healthy, and what to do with the finished compost. In addition, Agency staff will share helpful landscaping tips that could reduce the amount of yard waste you produce, along with tips to cut down on wasted food. If available, participants can take a bucket of chipped yard waste home to get their compost pile started or to use as mulch around plants. The next composting class will be Saturday, December 11th at 9:30AM and is expected to last approximately 45 minutes to one hour.
