The Agency encourages Tehama County residents to dispose of their old tires during this event. Tires collected will be recycled into waste tire derived products. This free event will accept passenger tires from Tehama County residents only. There are restrictions to the event:

- Up to 9 tires without exemption, 20 tires with exemption
- Multiple trips for a maximum of 40 tires will be accepted
- <u>No</u> large truck tires, equipment tires, off-road tires
- <u>No</u> tires larger than 17"
- <u>No</u> oil, paint, batteries, appliances, or other items
- Tires must be <u>Off-the-Rim</u> to be accepted
- <u>No</u> tires from waste tire generating businesses
- If tires were illegally dumped, call (530) 528-1103 for additional information

Electronic waste (e-waste) will NOT be accepted during these tire events. E-waste can be brought to the Tehama County/Red Bluff Landfill at no charge every day.
