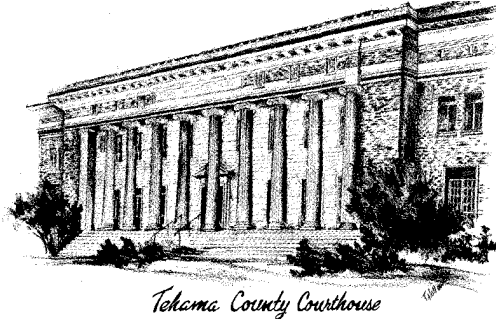

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the County of Tehama will receive sealed bids for Liquid Asphalt & Asphaltic Emulsions (CSS-1h and PMRE (Styra-Flex) Rejuvenating Emulsion or equivalent), in truckload quantities, for the period commencing on the date of Board of Supervisors approval through June 30, 2024 inclusive, in accordance with the information and specifications on file in the Office of the Tehama County Purchasing Agent, 727 Oak Street, Red Bluff, CA 96080, for the following:

**APPROXIMATELY**  
**1,200 TONS PMRE**  
**450 TONS CSS-1h**  
**(COMBINED TOTAL OF 1,650 TONS OF LIQUID ASPHALT)\***

\*Bidders may elect to bid on any or all products listed above.

Bids must be received at the Office of the Purchasing Agent, 727 Oak Street, Red Bluff, CA 96080 not later than 3pm on June 6, 2023. Bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes and marked “**LIQUID ASPHALT.**”

Tehama County reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or waive any irregularity in any bid received.

**COUNTY OF TEHAMA, State of California**  
**SPECIFICATIONS FOR LIQUID ASPHALT/ASPHALTIC EMUSSIONS**

**Liquid Asphalt/Asphaltic Emulsions** shall conform to the provisions of Section 93 Liquid Asphalts of the 2018 Standard Specifications of the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The County reserves the right to test and inspect all orders prior to acceptance. The quantities on the “Bid Schedule” are approximate only and are shown as a basis for comparison of bids only. The County of Tehama does not warrant, expressed or implied, that the actual quantities purchased will correspond therewith, but reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount as deemed necessary by the Director of Public Works.

Types of Liquid Asphalt/Asphaltic Emulsions for which bids are being solicited are CSS-1h, and PMRE/Styra-Flex Rejuvenating Emulsion or equivalent.

CSS-1h will be spread at a rate of 1:1 dilution ratio with water. (Note that payment will be made by ton without water.)

The term of this bid shall be effective on the Board of Supervisor (Board) approval date through June 30, 2024, inclusive. All material price bids shall be effective on the Board approval date. The price per ton submitted by each successful bidder (Bid Schedule “Price” divided by “Approx. Tons”) will be subject to adjustment for industry-wide price changes. In the event of industry price changes, either up or down, during the term of this bid, the County and each successful bidder will allow bid price adjustment to correspond with the industry fluctuation. An “industry-wide price change” means the net increase or decrease in the price per ton charged for similar materials by industrial suppliers located in California. The successful bidder and the County may each propose a price adjustment once per calendar quarter, at least 15 days before such proposed adjustment is to become effective. Such proposal shall state the percentage increase or decrease in price and the proposed adjusted price per ton. The percentage increase or decrease must be certified by at least two other industrial suppliers as reflecting an “industry-wide price change.”

Alternatively, payment adjustments may be made in accordance with Section 9-1.07 PAYMENT ADJUSTMENTS FOR PRICE INDEX FLUCTUATIONS, of Caltrans 2018 Standard Specifications, at the discretion of the Engineer.

The bid price adjustments provided herein, either up or down, will be reflected in each sub-award made after the effective date of the adjustment and will be shown separately on all invoices.

Each responsive bid will be placed on the County’s approved bid list, ranked from lowest to highest. For each road repair and maintenance project during the term of this bid, the County will determine whether the lowest bidder on the bid list has the required material available at the time and in the quantities needed for the project. If so, then a sub-award will be made to that bidder at the bid price on the approved bid list. If the lowest bidder does not have the required material available, the County will repeat the process with the next lowest bidder on the approved bid list and thereon, until a sub-award is made to the lowest bidder on approved bid list that has the required material available. The County shall have no obligation to make any purchase from any bidder until a written sub-award is made by the Purchasing Agent or designee. Nothing in this Proposal shall be construed to require the County to purchase any asphalt material types from any bidder that are not included within this proposal under any circumstances.

Bids and bid price per ton shall be for furnishing, delivering and spreading Liquid Asphalts and Asphaltic Emulsions within Tehama County. Bid price per ton shall be measured and paid by weight under the specifications requiring its use not including the weight of water, if used.

Bids will be evaluated and ranked based on an average of one hundred (100) tons of product plus 10 hours for two (2) spreader trucks at the bid hourly spread rate.
