REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: the update to Tehama LAFCO's current Policies, Procedures and Standards Manual are designed to address and conform to the changes in the state law and specifically the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, which have taken place since April 11, 1990 when the current document was adopted. The focus is on actions that provide policies on staffing, fees, Per Diem and Reimbursement, and procedures for processing change of organization/reorganization as specifically outlined in Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 and/or subsequent amendments.
