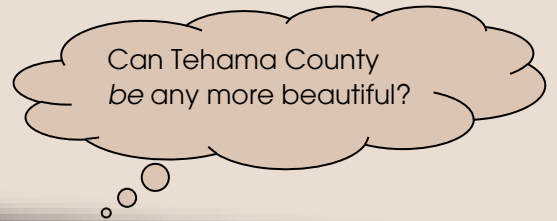


Let's be a friend to our Earth on April 22nd and every day, week, month, and year.
